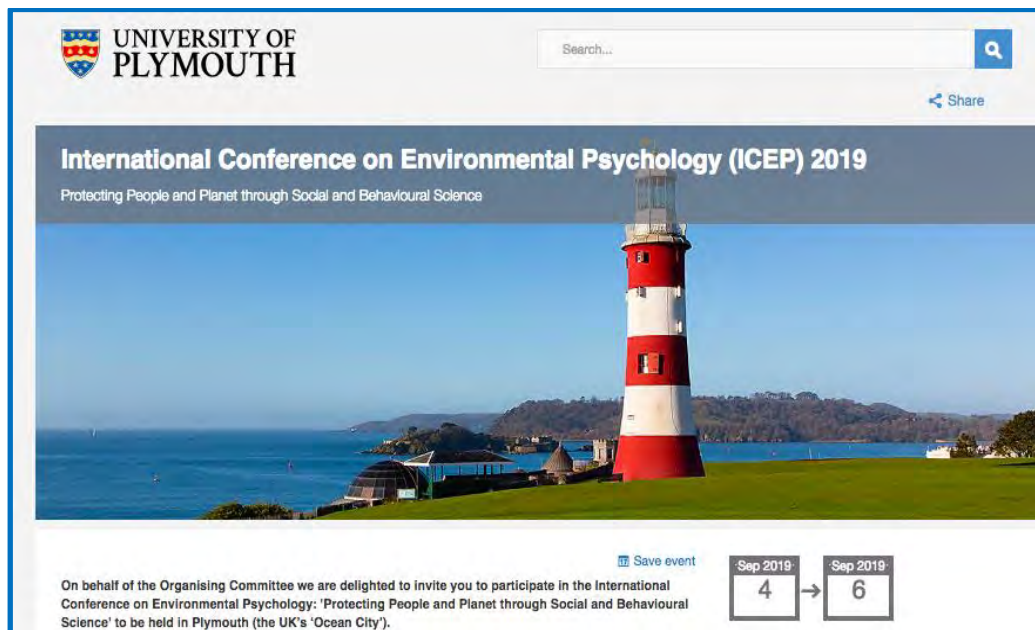

This research is of great social importance and Innovec'EAU addresses it through direct dialogue with its partners, the health sector, wastewater management companies, stakeholders, regulators, the pharmaceutical industry and the general public.
